## NORTH STAR MEMBER BACK FROM IRAQ

### Staff Sergeant Terry Kamp of the National Guard's 34th Infantry (Red Bull) Division Returns Home

After almost a yearlong deployment, Terry and the 34th Infantry (Red Bull) Division of the National Guard returned home in January.

Terry, who turned 60 on January 27, plays percussion in the guard's band. Until last year, the 34th's band spent most of its time playing concerts, in parades, at ball games and gubernatorial ceremonies. The band members never expected to be deployed to Iraq. So when they got word that they would ship out, "We were shocked," he said.

After nearly 30 years in the military, Terry could have taken a pass and retired from the National Guard. But that never crossed his mind, he was determined to go with his unit – "my people."

Terry has stayed in excellent shape, doing the required push-ups, situps and a 2-mile run to pass the physical fitness test each year. But the summer training before his March 2009 deployment nearly did him in. It was very tough... I just wanted to keep up with all the young guys in my unit.

The mission of the Red Bull Riders Country Band, one of several ensembles in his 36-member unit, was to bring entertainment to the troops at small bases where big-name entertainers couldn't go.

### 1953 STUDEBAKER 2R14A TRUCK

- Owner - J.B. Williams, Morton, MN
- Engine - 429 c.i. Mercury (1969)
- Transmission - Ford C-6 automatic
- Frame - 1976 Ford supercab pickup

This truck was purchased new by Untiedt Repair in Round Lake, MN and was the shop's wrecker. I bought it from them and did a full restoration on the body. I also did a complete ground-up rebuild of a 1976 Ford supercab frame that I then mounted the body on. I installed a 429 cubic inch big block Mercury V8 backed with a C-6 automatic transmission. The frame is the same width as the old Studebaker frame which made mounting the body quite easy. It provides a modern 1-ton twin I beam suspension, disc brakes, power steering and cruise control. The 8" x 16" wheels are from American Racing. The dashboard has been refitted with Dakota Digital gauges. This was a six year project.

## OFFICERS/DIRECTORS REPORTS

**Maynard Lemke, Director/Events,** contacted Ray Kroll about the “Eyes Right” Driving Tour scheduled for August 28th. Because of the many other events scheduled, it was decided that this Tour will be postponed until next year.

Maynard made a suggestion that the November/December Newsletter deadline be changed from November 10 to October 30, so everyone has time to read about the Chapter Christmas Party details. Dean will ask the Newsletter Editor about making this change.

**Jim Ringquist, Vice President/Donation Committee,** received a letter from Chapter members Denny and Carol Borich, regarding the Minnesota Museum of Mining in Chisholm, Minnesota, where 5,000 people visited last year. Denny and Carol have served on the Museum Board of Directors for five years and volunteer about 400 hours a year for the museum. They are requesting a donation to help build a secure exhibit building that is climate controlled for a very large model railroad diorama with a handmade train. The exhibit materials are old, fragile and one-of-a-kind. After discussing this request, a motion was made and passed for the Chapter to donate \$150.

There was a motion made to donate a \$50 Visa Gift Card to Ernie and Jean Loga, long-time Chapter Members, after they had a devastating house fire.

Because the Chapter supports certain events every year, it was discussed and motioned to have “Signature Events” that the Chapter will automatically support every year until it was decided not to.

The Chapter Signature Events are:

- 1) Pioneer Park (\$200)
- 2) Drive For Kids (to cover the members participation fees – in 2009 it was \$385)
- 3) Annual Swap Meet (\$150)

It was discussed and motioned to increase the renewed CD to \$2,500 by withdrawing \$456.93 from the Money Market account. This would bring the Money Market account balance to \$768.89. The checking account balance is \$2,586 and there is a five-year CD which was reinvested with \$5,205.39.

Dean reported about a large quantity of very old original Studebaker documents that are for sale. The Studebaker Museum would be very excited to receive these 90 items, but are not able to purchase them. There are a couple of investors that would like to purchase the items and donate all of them to the Museum, however, are not able to afford the sale price. If these items are not purchased together, they will be split up and sold individually on E-Bay. It was discussed and a motion was made that the Chapter would give \$250 to help purchase all 90 items with the stipulation that all items are donated to the Studebaker Museum.

There is interest from the Chapter members to purchase jackets with the Chapter logo. A new logo will need to be approved (which the Chapter must pay for to own exclusively). Our family history dates back to the 1800's in the town of Ellsworth, Wisconsin. My great-grandfather owned a feed mill and know that he had Studebaker wagons at the mill.

In 1902, James Cope ordered four 1902 Studebakers to be shipped by rail to his feed mill in Ellsworth. There was a promotion with these Studebakers. Each car sold, received a shot glass with a 1902 Studebaker inscribed on it.

James had two sons that worked at the mill and later bought it and did the same, ordering cars by four shipped by rail. Neil, my grandfather and brother (Uncle) Floyd ordered their last cars in 1950 which were Desoto four-doors.

We (Rita and Jerry) received three of these shot glasses from my parents estate in 2004. In 2008, we donated one shot glass to the Zone Meet put on by the North Star Chapter given for the raffle, or silent auction.
