- ▶ In 1997 Craig traded the 1952 Champion to Arnie Kimbrel for a **1964 Commander**.
- ▶ In 2003 Craig sold his 1949 Commander.
- ▶ In 2006 Craig sold the 1964 Commander.

From Highway 55 go west through Buffalo and Maple Lake. Continue west on 55, from the stop light in Maple Lake drive approximately 4 miles. Turn right (north) on County Road 6 (before Lampi Auction). Proceed north 3/4 of a mile and take first right onto 70th St. Proceed past Whispering Pines Golf Club. Make a sharp right turn onto Ireland Ave. We are the first home on the left, 6828 Ireland Ave.

From I-94 go south at the Clearwater junction on Highway 24 (exit 178) for approximately 10 miles. Watch for County Road 6 and a sign for Whispering Pines Golf Course. Turn left for 2 miles. You may encounter a barricade so follow Isaak Ave. NW along the scenic lake drive to 78th St. NW which will bring you back to County Road 6. Continue to 70th St., turn Left, past Whispering Pines Golf Course to Ireland Ave. We are the first home on the left. Look for the Studebaker wagon.

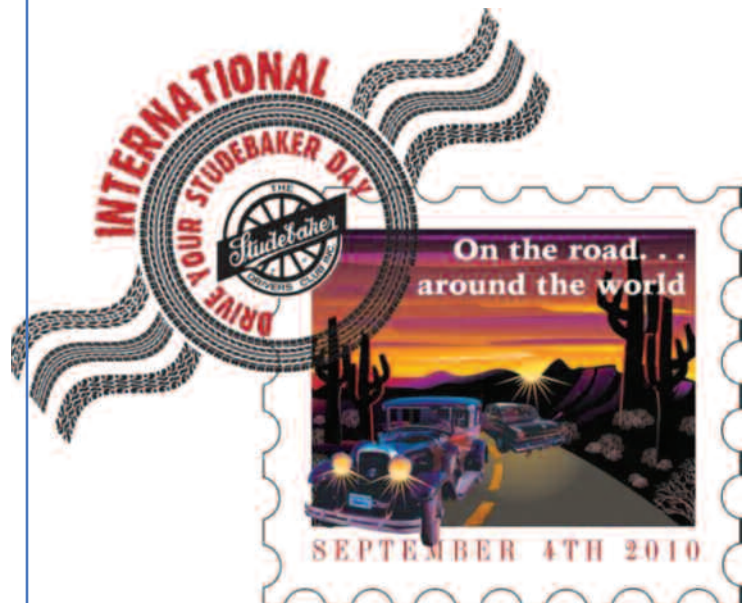
