Minutes April 7, 2005 Meeting Studebaker Drivers Club. Thirty-one members were present at The Old Country Buffet in Maple Grove, MN. Motion was made to accept the minutes of the March meeting. The treasurer's report was read.

The Chapter received thank-you notes for the \$100 each for trophies from the committees of the upcoming Regional and International meets.

Activities Director Maynard Lemke spoke of the various places our club is getting ink regarding club activities. It is important to get our name out to help draw new members and increase the interest in preserving the Studebaker heritage.

Maynard asked for volunteers for the Poker Run that will be July 23, originating from the Lemke home in Plymouth.

President Pearson made available copies of the new club by-laws to anyone present wanting them.

Arlan Vollan brought samples of the new club shirts in denim and khaki. They will be \$20 including shipping. Polo shirts will be available for \$30. Call Arlan to order. Arlan also reported on "Get the Cars Out" which will originate from his place in Red Wing.

Letters of invitation are being sent to non North Star Chapter SDC members within a specific radius from Red Wing in order to encourage possible new members. Arlan has arranged for a special garage tour, a viewing of a Depression glass collection as well as lunch for "Get the Cars Out" attendees.

There will be no meeting at this event as neither the President nor Vice-President will be able to attend. It was agreed to hold a meeting on May 1st at noon at the Buick Show that is being held at the State Fair Grounds.

It was approved at the Board Meeting to again donate \$250 to the upcoming Drive for Kids, which will allow members six cars to participate. This is being used as an example for the committee of this function to present to other car clubs to encourage participation in this very worthwhile event.

Trophies have been ordered for the Memorial Day Car Show and Orphan Car Show Labor Day weekend. These events are listed in the MSRA Line Chaser publication. Flyers will be sent to everyone that attended these events the previous year as well.

The April/May newsletter is going to be sent to about 240± non North Star Chapter SDC Members in Minnesota with an invitation to join the North Star Chapter.

Dues notices will be mailed to all members in May in a separate envelope. Please pay upon receipt to avoid necessary follow-up.

President Pearson asked for volunteers to help set up and take down for the Memorial Day Car Show.

Ed Skomoroh initiated a lengthy discussion regarding the Board's recent decision to change the present schedule of nine newsletters per year to six issues; the stipulation that all members get printed copies, (even though quite a few want only the email version) and elimination of the email newsletter. The newsletter is a very important component of our club and our members need to be aware of the many fun and worthwhile activities. Reducing the number of newsletters reduces the viability and participation at club activities. After lengthy discussion: M-Arlan Vollan/S-Todd Langenfeld/Carried to recommend the Board rescind their decision and go back to the previous schedule for nine newsletters, permit the option for email only newsletters and continue the email version of the newsletter. Further that the Dues renewal form offer a preference as to whether a member wishes to only receive the email version of the newsletter.

M-Cheryl/S-John/Carried to list future board meetings in the newsletter. The Bylaws indicate general membership can attend these meetings and notice should be given.

M-Maynard/S-Gary/Carried that in the future the Board will consider bringing issues to the membership meetings for discussion and recommendations from the membership so the Board has memberships opinions before they vote on important matters. Meeting adjourned.
