Zone Meet Wrapup. . . .



After 3 years of planning for the fun weekend it's now time to report on the Zone Meet.

First, I would like to say a hearty thanks to all the committee members who came to all the planning meetings and all the members of the North Star Chapter and other folks that volunteered their time to help make the Zone Meet a success. There were a total of 99 registrations, including 20 walk-ins. There were 43 North Star Chapter members registered. We had 42 judged vehicles and 29 display vehicles. We judged 11 Watches and 5 Toys/Models. The Ladies Tour had 13 participants. 15 for the Car cruise. The Banquet had 127. (Be attendees. A Super Evening!

Positive feedback from many: Best "Goody Bag" and contents. Special thanks to all the members that rounded up donations!

Preliminary financial numbers indicate that we made a small profit and have very little memorabilia inventory to clear out. A detailed financial report is being completed. Here is a unaudited result for the Zone Meet. \$1,042 income from the raffle, \$769 income from the silent auction. Our checkbook balance reads \$7,296.96. When we subtract the club advance of \$1,786, we have \$5,510.96. From this balance we still owe Jean for ink, paper, and mailings. We owe Bob Shaw for plaques; I believe we also owe Dean and Doug Brown for the table centers. However a quick estimate tells me we still should have a balance of around \$5,000.00 after all bills are paid. We do not usually put out financial numbers in the newsletter but in this case Dean and I agreed that you should know what your Zone Meet Committee and other accomplished. Not bad for amateurs. **It was a "Great Success!"**

The North Star Wheel is created with the great Adobe Acrobat software and most computers today have the free Acrobat Reader. A really neat feature (if you have the current free Acrobat Reader) is that you notice your mouse 'finger' or 'go live' when you pass it over email addresses or web page URLs in this newsletter. CLICK when you see that action and you'll either get taken to that web site by your browser or your email window will pop up for sending an email message. That will make it quick & easy for you to dash off a sympathy note, a question about an event or your idea for something in the North Star Wheel.

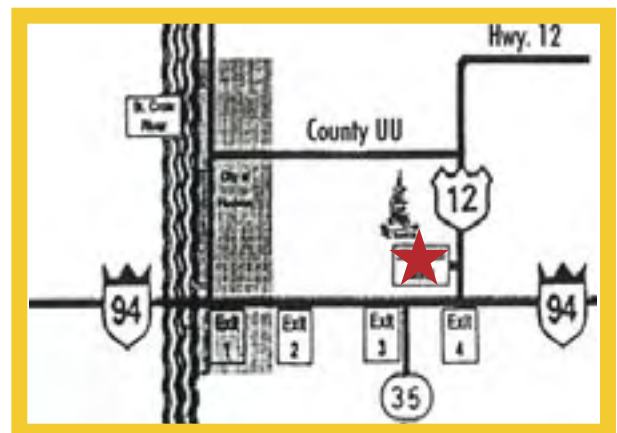
