## Member Spotlight

This issue's Member Spotlight is on Shirley Van Dell. Shirley was born in Proctor, Minnesota, April 4, 1923. Studebaker lineage began very early in Shirley's life. Her dad had used Studebaker wagons in logging and farming, then owned exclusively Studebakers, including a 1915, 1919, 1926 Big Six, a 1937 Dictator (which Shirley says she totaled) and finally a 1940 Commander Sedan.

Shirley and Leslie were married in December, 1942. They moved across Boundary Ave. to Duluth in 1952, raised seven children, six boys, Jim, Rick, Terry, Ron, Mike & Scott, and one girl, Verie. Shirley worked as a branch manager for several party plans during the fifties and early sixties.

In their younger years they had a 1931 Studebaker (which Shirley also wrecked!!). In more recent years, they owned a '55 Commander, two '62 Daytona's (one of which, Leslie wrecked), a '62 Lark 4-door and a '66 Cruiser. Their real pride & joy was the 1947 Champion 2-door Deluxe which was sold after Leslie's passing in July, 1996.

Son, Jim had enrolled his folks in SDC in 1968 and from then forward Shirley carried the torch for Studebaker in Northern Minnesota. She was appointed by Mike Cornell as Asst. Regional Director for Northern Minnesota in 1971-72. She served as Editor of the North Star Wheel Newsletter from 1979 thru 1994, winning numerous SDC National awards, including a Senior 1st, during her 15 year tenure.

Shirley & Leslie were instrumental in chartering the North Land Wheels Chapter in 1974, which serves Northern MN, Northwestern Wisconsin and adjacent areas of Ontario. The chapter hosted the 1993 SDC Zone Meet in Duluth and this year will be putting on its 36th Annual Swap Meet & Car Show on Sunday, August 5th, 2007.

Shirley served as Upper Mississippi Valley Zone Coordinator from the inception of SDC zones until retiring in 1996. In 1986 she initiated the Northern Region of the MN Car Club Assn. and helped coordinate car events for the next 13 years. She has also served as MN Regional Manager from 2004 until the current term.

She presently holds NLW Chapter positions as Treasurer and Membership and is chairing the swap meet end of things for the umpteenth time. Shirley also holds supporting memberships in the North Star, Badger Wheels and Wisconsin Region Chapters. Shirley

isn't able to get around as well as she would like to anymore, but she certainly has done a great job in promoting Studebaker and SDC over her many years of dedicated service.

We appreciate all you've done for both of the Minnesota chapters, the international Studebaker Drivers Club, and the car hobby in general.

## Tip 88, Worlds's Most Wonderfu / Studebaker Mechanic. . . .

As those Studebaker Drivers that have followed the illustrious adventures of the World's Most Wonderful Mechanic (WMWM) probably know, this industrious troglodyte of questionable intelligence, lies awake at night conjuring up techniques that will make the lives of those same Studebaker Drivers easier, safer and more wonderful.

The WMWM refers to these techniques as Tech Tips and he numbers them for future reference. Many Studebaker drivers print these tech tips and sell them to the Studebaker show car people.

The show car people have no clue what these tech tips refer to, but think they are genuine and pay hundreds of dollars for these tips to add to their ever expanding collection of authentic Studebaker memorabilia and paraphernalia.

Recently, while servicing his '63 Studebaker Champ V8 powered pick up truck, he noted that the hood prop rod holding the hood up, had come loose and the hood of this wonderful V8 powered truck was threatening to fall on the WMWM's fat head.

The WMWM noted that the goofy little clip that secures the prop rod to the fender tab, had disappeared. A replacement clip was not found in his remarkable collection of Studebaker clips and pins that he had harvested over the past 29 years of Studebaker mechanicing..
