North Star Board Meeting. . . .

February 5, 2008 at Lunds in Plymouth, MN Members Present: Dean Elstad, Maynard & Joan Lemke, Jim & Cheryl Rock, Rose & Mike Price

Maynard Lemke, Director, announced changes for the 2008 Event Calendar: 1) Get The Cars Out will be held May 17th (not the 10th). 2) The Midwest Studebaker SWAP MEET will be on Saturday, September 27th. Motion-Jim/Seconded Maynard. Approved-all in favor.

Joan Lemke, Treasurer, gave the Treasurer's Report with current balances. A decision was made to continue with \$15 Membership Dues. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Jim. Approved-all in favor.

Discussed Chapter Meeting Thursday, Feb. 7th at Angeno's Pizza in Maple Grove. There is a 20-person minimum for the group meeting room. Dean will ask Henry Votel, Membership Director, to send out reminder e-mails to all members.

Jim Rock, Director, shared a comment he received from another member about how the Board is set up. A suggestion was heard to have different car club members serve on our Board of Directors. This was discussed and rejected at this time. Jim Rock announced the new shirts will be here at the Chapter Meeting on Thursday, Feb. 7th.

Dean Elstad, President, will ask Henry Votel to print the updated Member Directory into booklets and to update the By-Laws. Henry will then send these out to all members. Dean Elstad discussed the 2008 Budget. Decision was made to donate \$250 to the Hugo Food Shelf. Motion- Jim/Seconded-Maynard. Approved-all in favor.

*Hennepin Technical College Scholarship. Discussed a 2 year commitment for \$1,000 each year. We can give the criteria to fill for the scholarship, such as; program of study, grade point average, financial need, second-year student. We also may be able to meet the scholarship recipient in September after the scholarship is

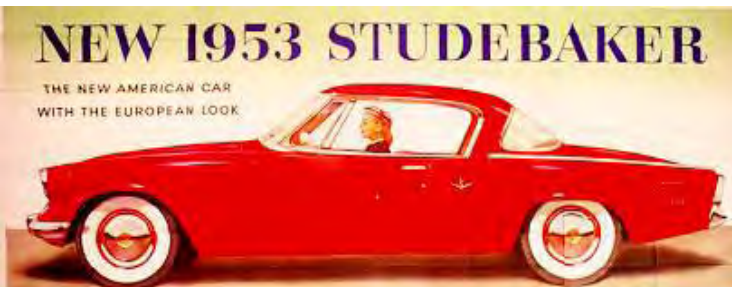
at \$1,000 per year. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Joan. Approved-all in favor.

*Hunger Solutions Minnesota (this is the parent of all food shelves in Minnesota and they distribute food where it is needed most) Dean proposed to: 1) match the \$250 Hugo Food Shelf donation 2) donate \$100 to the Annandale Food Shelf (where Ed & Jean Skomoroh are involved) 3) donate \$1,150 to Hunger Solutions Minnesota. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Jim. Approved-all in favor. Because June is a "needy" month, we will use the funds from the March maturity of the \$1,500 CD to make these donations.

*Operation Uplink (they send phone cards to those in the military so they can call home) Dean proposed we donate \$250 to Operation Uplink. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Jim. Approved-all in favor.

*Discussed what to do with the \$4,000 left in the accounts at the end of 2008. Joan proposed to table this decision and wait until the Zone Meet is over before deciding on what to do with other money, at which time, we will know amount of profits from the Zone Meet. Motion-Jim/Seconded-Maynard. Approved-all in favor. *LCD Projector. Discussed the need to purchase one, which would be used at the Zone Meet and at future Chapter Meetings. Bob Shaw has great knowledge about these. Dean is willing to research it, purchase and store it. Ed Skomoroh is willing to use his laptop.

Dean proposed to bring this suggestion to purchase an LCD Projector, with a maximum cost of \$500, to the Members at the Chapter Meeting on Thursday, Feb. 7th. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Jim. Approved-all in favor.



*Pioneer Park in Annandale, MN Maynard proposed a \$200 donation to Pioneer Park. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Jim. Approved-all in favor.

*Drive For Kids. Proposed \$300 for 7 cars to participate in Drive For Kids. Motion-Joan/Seconded-Maynard. Approved-all in favor.

Review of the charitable contributions seem to cover a wide variety of activities. Members are pleased to be able to assist others from the Chapters' profits. Any comments or suggestions by other Members are always welcome. Dean will write a letter to the Blacksmith Lounge informing them of money we donated to the Hugo Food Shelf from the Car Show profits.

By-Laws changes approved in 2006 require a Nominations Committee present a slate of candidates. Last year we started too late. This year a Candidate Search Committee for new officers will be formed in September. The positions of President, Treasurer and one Director are all up for election in January, 2009.

Board Meetings were scheduled for 2008 on Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. at Lunds in Plymouth: April 1st, July 8th, October 7th Meeting Adjourned. Motion-Maynard/Seconded-Jim. Approved-all in favor.

Riveting and exciting "Studey" stories were shared by members. Pictures were shared and members could keep ones they wanted.

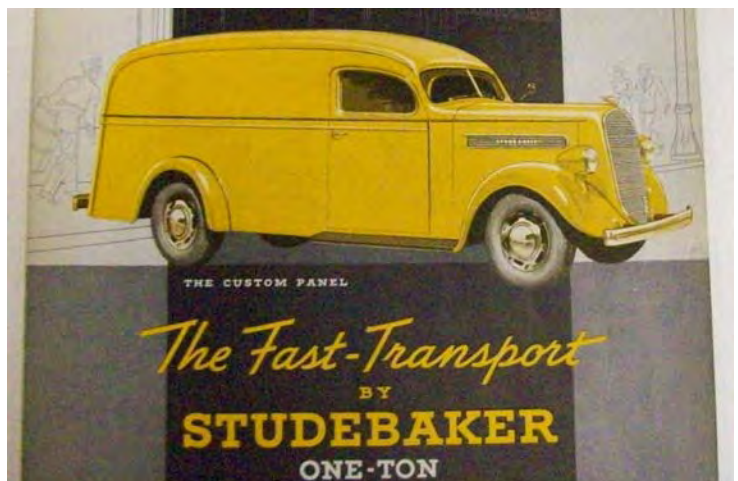
Raffle Drawing was held with winner keeping half and other half going to the Zone Meet.

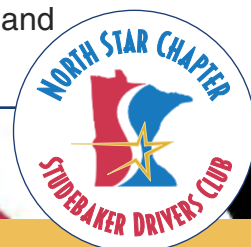
