Zone Meet News

2008 North Star Zone Meet Meeting Minutes, April 5, 2008 Best Western-Kelly Inn in Plymouth, MN MEETING called to order at 1:40 P.M. MINUTES from the March 10th meeting were approved. Motioned Maynard Lemke/Seconded-Jim Rock.



HOTEL LAYOUT: Ed brought a large map of the hotel to show where everything is located. Discussed where the cars would be parked, where the reserved hotel rooms were located, the locations of the Hospitality Room (Room 264), Banquet Room (Sunset Room) and the room where the Toys/Watches would be judged (Patio Room), the Entrance E for the Pizza and beer Friday night. Also discussed the possibilities of where to have the cars washed, parking for the tow trucks and where the vendors will be. The swap meet could be on the grassy area. The parking on the west side is all for us and will be blocked off. There is a water spigot to wash cars, but we need to supply the hoses.

WALK THROUGH: the hotel and parking lot. -Pool area: There is a great pool if members want to bring kids/grandkids. Poolside rooms cost more than the \$84 for a regular room, but will get a discount from the Studebaker group. -Hospitality Room has a good setup with a couch, table, restroom and microwave. -Entrance E will be where the hotel sells pizza, beer and soft drinks on Friday night 6- 8:30 pm. The hotel takes care of the food and staff for this. (No financial commitment to the chapter) -Outside water spigot will be used to wash the cars. Sandy Bergeron has some hoses we can use. Need to look at providing buckets, soap and towels. The hotel may provide old towels. -Parking for the tow vehicles could be in a couple different locations. Still to be decided on. Ed and Maynard will do some further checking on this -Parking for the show cars. There are 20 cars signed up for judging and 11 for showing. There are 100 spots available. -Barricades and Signage. Jerome Vanderlinde can get cones from his work that we can use. We will need ropes and volunteers to man the ropes and parking lots -Security. We must provide. -Friday at Noon all prep workers should be at the hotel to help set up.

CHAIR REPORTS & OTHER DETAILS: **Signage:** Dean and Bob Shaw are in charge. Suggestion was made to have lots of large and clear signage within and outside the hotel. Every Chairperson needs to tell Dean exactly what kind of sign they will need. Also, will need to provide our own easels. Maynard has 3, Ed -1.

Goody Bags: Sandy reported that donations are coming in, but is still looking for more. Dean and Sandy will assemble these at home. Hotel Layout Map: Jean will have Bob Shaw enlarge map to be put in the Zone Meet Book and also at the registration desk.

Silent Auction: Dean is in charge and looking for anything to be donated (does not have to be Studebaker related). Schedule 5:30 – 7pm located either in the Patio room or outside the Banquet room.

Registration: Jean Skomoroh has enough volunteers at this time.

Table Centers: Discussed using the hotel's fake plants for no cost. Doug Brown will be making centerpieces (models) which will be used for the Door Prizes. Any left over can go in the Silent Auction. Decision needs to be made about using both plants and models for centerpieces or only going with the models. There will be 20 tables for 200 people (with 8–10 people at each table depending on how many meals are presold). There will be a sign-up sheet at the registration for people to decide which table to sit at (at the Banquet). The Banquet Room will be ready for us to set it up on Saturday at 8 AM.

Bus Tour: 10 – 2pm to Maple Grove, Arbor Lakes shopping malls. Lunch is on your own, and shuttles will go to both shopping areas. Cell phone numbers will be distributed in case anyone is left behind. Maynard is in charge.

Driving Tour: - After autos are judged and shoppers return tour will start at 2:30 to Elingson's Auto Museum and then drive to Cabela's, where part of the parking lot will be blocked off for Studebakers. Maps will be available. Discussed having a North Star member every 5th car so as not to lose anyone. Jodi France will see if her friend will be a motorcycle escort.

Dash Plaques and Awards. Samples were at each table and all agreed they look very nice. Bob Shaw is chairing the plaque assembly and needs volunteers. Bob

has also developed an excellent website and is in charge of all advertising and promotions for our event.

Ads for the Meet Book: Bob Shaw is putting this together. There are many ads purchased already but the back page is still available for \$100. and \$50. for full-page ad and \$35. for half-page. Maynard reported on the local businesses. Green Mill has put in an ad and Cabela's is working on it. McDonald's will donate free ice and something for the Goody Bag. Red Robin will take out an ad or donate something. Maynard will approach the new Subway for a donation. There will be a detailed map of the hotel layout and a map of local businesses in the Book.

Judges: Todd L. and Arlan V are the co-chairs. We now have 14 judges. Keith Rust and Craig Harrison will judge models/watches. Pre-registration is encouraged, but it's okay to register up 9am Saturday. All Judges will wear a red JUDGE badge. There will be breakfast and box lunches available for Judges. Breakfast will be served at 7 am and a box lunch at 12pm. In the Patio Room. Maynard and Rock will determine the menu.

Vendors: Will pay a fee unless they are selling Studebaker items, or if they place an ad in the Zone Meet Book. No one is signed up yet, but we expect several late requests. Security: Doug Brown will head Security.

Hospitality: Joan Lemke will have a sign-up sheet (at the Get The Cars Out event, May 17th at Jean & Ed Skomoroh's.) for donations of bars, chips, pretzels, popcorn, cheese, cups, etc. Joan will go to Sam's Club the week before the Zone Meet to purchase whatever else is needed that did not get donated.

Photography: Ed Bauer assisted by Gene Bauer will take photos of the cars on Friday afternoon and Saturday morning. Also, he will take photos of the toys and watches for the Awards Banquet.

Raffle Tickets: Keith and Karen Rust are in charge. We are almost at \$1,000 sold. If all tickets are sold, it will total \$2,000.

Truck & Trailer Parking: Maynard and Ed are working on. They need to receive the confirmations.

Memorabilia Sales: Jim Ringquist will have a table at the reception area. Banquet: There will be a Country Western Band playing popular music from the 50-60's.

Pizza, Beer and Soft Drinks: on Friday night from 6-8:30 PM at Entrance E. The hotel provides the food and staff for this event. Not free, people must pay for this. (no financial obligation to the Chapter)

Judging Watches: John Morneau will display his collection and give out awards

Host Member ID: Jean has the red-white-blue ribbon to attach under name tags to identify us as hosts of the Meet.

Meet Book Contents: Reviewed contents - Welcome letters from Ed, President, and a letter from the City of Plymouth, proclaiming it the City of "Studebaker". Schedule of Events, with a pocket card schedule that will be handed out at registration. Tour descriptions. Map of the local area with gas stations, car washes, drugstores, groceries and churches. History of the North Star Chapter, with a copy of Doug's model. "Thank You" to all sponsors. Need to include a list of auto classes. Need to have an ad for Swap Meet in Hudson, WI. Bob Shaw will need to contact Channel 11 and 12 to cover event. Also contact the Star Tribune and write an article before the Meet. Maynard will contact the local Plymouth newspaper prior to the event. Need to have article of all donations (food shelves, scholarship funding) given by the North Star Chapter. Ed suggests that this might be part of the Presidents Letter.

Volunteer Sign-up: Jean & Ed asked for volunteers, where needed, and people signed up. Jean will put together the complete list for mailing.

NEXT MEETING is scheduled for Monday, May 19th at 7:00 PM at the Best Western-Kelly Inn, Plymouth in the Patio Room.

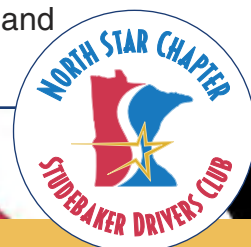
